Recently, we were talking about the character of God. Each person was asked to write a God Haiku, highlighting God's character as he or she sees it.

What is a Haiku?

A Haiku combines form, content, and language while using simple words and grammar. A Haiku does "paint" a mental image in the reader's mind, but does not rhyme. The most common form for Haiku is three short lines; line 1 contains five (5) syllables, line 2 contains seven (7) syllables, and line 3 contains five (5) syllables. Try writing one of your own. They are wonderful...
